

The Tiverton Fire Department had quite a task on Wednesday evening, March 14th, trying to find a fire that was reported to them about 5:00 p.m.

Anyone driving along the B-line or Bruce 15 near Inverhuron would have seen plenty of smoke coming from somewhere in the bush between Victoria Street and the B-Line.

Unfortunately, because of the location and time spent trying to find ^{access}, by the time they were able to reach the home it was fully engulfed and couldn't be saved. There was also damage to many out-buildings and equipment.

This fire was at a seasonal home located off Victoria Street in Inverhuron. Fire crews were at the site until the wee hours of the morning and had to come back the next morning with a tractor to make sure it was completely extinguished

Area residents gathered to express their concerns that, if this had been a dry summer month or if the snow had been too deep leading up to the residence, it would have been much more difficult for the fire crew
